Hopkins shocked at Prime Minister's political cowardice

Kris Hopkins, the Conservative Prospective Parliamentary Candidate for Keighley and Ilkley, has described Prime Minister Gordon Brown's decision to pull back from calling an autumn General Election as "an act of gross political cowardice."

He commented:

"I am extremely disappointed that voters will not now have a chance to pass judgement on this failing Labour Government for perhaps two or more years.

"Gordon Brown's career is littered with examples of him ducking out of taking difficult decisions, but this fiasco puts them all in the shade.

"The Prime Minister has put his party's interests ahead of the best interests of our country in what amounts to an act of gross political cowardice."
