## Hopkins praises Cameron's "heartfelt" Conference speech

Speaking from the Winter Gardens in Blackpool this afternoon where he was present to witness David Cameron's speech to Conservative Conference delegates, Kris Hopkins, the Conservative Parliamentary Candidate for Keighley and Ilkley, said:
